Subject: Early Intervention Compliance for State Fiscal Year 2012

Date: February 16, 2012

The Bureau of Early Intervention Services (BEIS) will begin examining Early Intervention (Part C) Compliance data in March to determine statewide and county-specific compliance. This data will be reported to the U.S. Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programming (OSEP) in upcoming reports.

ODH/BEIS will continue to utilize a cyclical monitoring cycle. In other words, we will review all 88 counties in all three compliance areas (i.e., Transition Planning Conferences, Timely Receipt of Services, and 45-Day) over a three-year period. **We will be examining Transition data, including Transition Planning Conferences (TPC) and Steps, beginning in March.**

Your county has not been selected to be included in the upcoming Transition analysis. Instead, your county will be included in the SFY12 45-Day analysis that is scheduled to occur in September. You will receive additional information at a later date regarding the timeline for this data analysis.
