Subject: Early Intervention Compliance for State Fiscal Year 2012 – Timely Receipt of Services

Date: May 23, 2012

The Bureau of Early Intervention Services (BEIS) began examining Early Intervention (Part C) Compliance data in March to determine statewide and county-specific compliance. These data will be reported to the U.S. Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programming (OSEP) in upcoming reports.

ODH/BEIS will continue to utilize a cyclical monitoring cycle. In other words, we will review all 88 counties in all three compliance areas (i.e., Transition Planning Conferences, Timely Receipt of Services, and 45-Day) over a three-year period. We will be examining Timely Receipt of Services (TRS) beginning in June.

**Your county has not been selected to be included in the upcoming TRS analysis.** Instead, your county will be included in the SFY12 45-Day analysis that is scheduled to occur in September. You will receive additional information at a later date regarding the timeline for this data analysis.
