Footnotes

SPP/APR Indicator - This field refers to a specific outcome reported to the U.S. Department of Education's Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) as part of the State Performance Plan (SPP) and Annual Performance Report (APR).

County Performance - This field provides the actual performance of the local county program.

Statewide Performance - This field provides the actual performance of the entire state.

Statewide Target - This field shows the goal established for the state in the SPP/APR, where a (1) indicates a compliance indicator and a (2) indicates a performance indicator. The U.S. Department of Education established a target of 100% for compliance indicators. For performance indicators, the State of Ohio established the statewide target in the original SPP submitted to the Department of Education in December 2005..

Note that for each of the indicators reported **NA** denotes an item as "Not Applicable". "Not applicable" indicators are items that either are new measures or measures for which data has not yet been collected. For example, targets have not yet been established by the U.S. Dept. of Education for child outcome measures (Indicators 3a, 3b and 3c).
