Footnotes

SPP/APR Indicator

This field refers to a specific outcome reported to the U.S. Department of Education's Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP) as part of the State Performance Plan (SPP) and Annual Performance Report (APR).

County Performance

This field provides the **actual performance** of the local county program.

Statewide Performance

This field provides the **actual performance** of the entire state.

Statewide Target

This field shows the **performance goal** established for the state in the SPP/APR where a (1) indicates a compliance indicator and a (2) indicates a performance indicator. The U.S. Department of Education established a target of 100% for compliance indicators. For performance indicators, the State of Ohio established a statewide target in the original SPP submitted to the Department of Education in December 2005.

NOTE

For each of the indicators, **NA** denotes an item as "Not Applicable". "Not Applicable" indicators are items for which there are no data.

*Ohio has chosen to use a cyclical monitoring cycle for the Timely Receipt of Services (Indicator 1), 45 Day (Indicator 7) and Transition (Indicators 8a and 8c) analyses. EIS programs were selected to be included in the analysis for one of the three indicators in FFY10, and will be included in the other two analyses over the next two fiscal years. Lucas County was selected for the 45 Day analysis for FFY10 and will be included in the Transition analysis in FFY11 and Timely Receipt of Services analysis in FFY12.
