**Date:** July 25, 2011

The Bureau of Early Intervention Services is offering subsidized Parents As Teachers trainings this fiscal year. Note that there are local costs associated with some of the trainings. There are a limited number of training slots available and registration will be prioritized for new HMG Home Visitors and Supervisors. Any remaining available slots will be on a first come, first serve basis for re-training. In SFY12 BEIS will continue to focus on the training of new Home Visitors and Supervisors. In the coming years, as funds are available, PAT retraining may be available through BEIS.

- New Help Me Grow Home Visitors are required to successfully complete both the Foundational training (3 days) and the Model Implementation training (2 days) to become a PAT certified Parent Educator. Both trainings must be face-to-face.
- New Help Me Grow Supervisors are required to complete the Model Implementation training (2 days) to become a PAT certified supervisor for parent educators. New supervisors are encouraged to attend the Foundational training.
- All PAT Parent Educators and Supervisors trained in the *Born to Learn* curriculum are required to be re-trained in the Foundational and Model Implementation trainings by July, 2014.
- The Model Implementation training will be available online in October, 2011 for certified Parent Educators and Supervisors. More information about this availability will be coming as it is made available from PAT.

ODH BEIS SFY 12 Parents As Teachers Trainings

**Foundational Training (3 days, formerly known as *Born to Learn* Training)**

- October 3-5, 2011 Franklin County (For HMG staff only)
- 2 other training sessions will be scheduled this fiscal year

Registration for the Foundational Training is a two-step process. Training participants are required first to register in Ohio Train and second, email [Lisa.Schwarz@parentsasteachers.org](mailto:Lisa.Schwarz@parentsasteachers.org) for a Parents As Teachers Foundation training application. Staff will be registered only after they receive confirmation from Lisa that she has received all required documentation. At the completion of the training, BEIS will receive the names of staff certified either as PAT parent educators, PAT supervisors or both which will be entered into Ohio Train. Participants will then be able to print their certificates from Ohio Train. The process of receiving names from the National Center for Parents as Teacher and entering the information into Ohio Train takes at least 3 weeks from the dates of the training. Each program has a program code number issued by the National Center for Parents As Teachers that is required on the registration form. Please give the program code number to all staff registering for the Foundational training.

**Model Implementation Training (2 days, formerly known as *Born to Learn* Training)**

- October 6-7, 2011 Franklin County (For HMG staff only)
- 2 other training sessions will be scheduled this fiscal year

Registration for the Program Implementation Training is a two-step process. Training participants are required first to register in Ohio Train and second, email [Lisa.Schwarz@parentsasteachers.org](mailto:Lisa.Schwarz@parentsasteachers.org) for a Parents As Teachers Program Implementation application. Staff will be registered only after they receive confirmation from Lisa that she has received all required documentation. At the completion of the training, BEIS will receive the names of staff certified either as PAT parent educators, PAT supervisors or both, which will then be entered into Ohio Train. Participants will then be able to print their certificates from Ohio Train. The process of receiving names from the National Center for Parents as Teacher and entering the information into Ohio Train takes at least 3 weeks from the dates of the training. Each program has a program code number issued by the National Center for Parents As Teachers that is required on the registration form. Please give the program code number to all staff registering for the Program Implementation training.

### **Parents As Teachers: Building Relationships within Family Systems (2 days)**

- 1 session will be scheduled this fiscal year
- Cost: \$50.00 materials fee per person

BEIS will subsidize the Building Relationships within Family Systems training. Participants will be required to pay a \$50.00 materials fee. The order and purchase of the materials is through the National Center for Parents As Teachers.

Registration for the Building Relationships within Family Systems training is a two-step process. Training participants are required first to register in Ohio Train and second, email [ann.haffner@parentsasteachers.org](mailto:ann.haffner@parentsasteachers.org) for a Building Relationships within Family Systems training application. Staff will be registered only after they receive confirmation from Ann that she has received all required documentation. At the completion of the training, BEIS will receive the attendance lists from both days of the training which will be entered into Ohio Train. Participants will then be able to print their certificates from Ohio Train. The process of receiving names from the National Center for Parents as Teacher and entering the information into Ohio Train takes at least 3 weeks from the dates of the training. Each program has a program code number issued by the National Center for Parents As Teachers that is required on the registration form. ### **Parents As Teachers: Supporting Families of Children with Special Needs (1 day)**

- 1 session will be scheduled this fiscal year
- Cost: \$100.00 materials fee per person plus shipping and handling

BEIS will subsidize the training Supporting Families of Children with Special Needs. Participants will be required to pay for the training manuals for the Supporting Families training at \$100.00 per manual plus S & H. The order and purchase of the manual is through the National Center for Parents As Teachers. County programs that have purchased the manual in the last few years can have staff attending the training bring the county's copy of the manual to the training.

Registration for the Supporting Families of Children with Special Needs training is a two-step process. Training participants are required first to register in Ohio Train and second, email [ann.haffner@parentsasteachers.org](mailto:ann.haffner@parentsasteachers.org) for a Supporting Families of Children with Special Needs training application. Staff will be registered only after they receive confirmation from Ann that she has received all required documentation. At the completion of the training, BEIS will receive the attendance list from the training which will be entered into Ohio Train. Participants will then be able to print their certificates from Ohio Train. The process of receiving names from the National Center for Parents as Teacher and entering the information into Ohio Train takes at least 3 weeks from the dates of the training. Each program has a program code number issued by the National Center for Parents As Teachers that is required on the registration form. ### Parents As Teachers: Working with Diverse Families (1 day)

Registration for the Working with Teen Parents training is a two-step process. Training participants are required first to register in Ohio Train and second, email [ann.haffner@parentsasteachers.org](mailto:ann.haffner@parentsasteachers.org) for a Parents As Teachers Working with Teen Parents training application. Staff will be registered only after they receive confirmation from Ann that she has received all required documentation. At the completion of the training, BEIS will receive the attendance lists from both days of the training which will be entered into Ohio Train. Participants will then be able to print their certificates from Ohio Train. The process of receiving names from the National Center for Parents as Teacher and entering the information into Ohio Train takes at least 3 weeks from the dates of the training.
