Subject: Early Intervention Compliance for State Fiscal Year 2012 – 45 Day

Date: September 19, 2012

The Bureau for Children with Medical Handicaps & Early Intervention Services (BCMHEIS) began examining Early Intervention (Part C) Compliance data in March to determine statewide and county-specific compliance. These data will be reported to the U.S. Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programming (OSEP) in upcoming reports.

ODH/BCMHEIS will continue to utilize a cyclical monitoring cycle. In other words, we will review all 88 counties in all three compliance areas (i.e., Transition Planning Conferences, Timely Receipt of Services, and 45 Day) over a three-year period. We examined Transition data, including Transition Planning Conferences (TPC) and Steps, in March 2012 and Timely Receipt of Services (TRS) in June. We will begin examining 45 Day in October.

Your county has not been selected to be included in the upcoming 45 Day analysis. Instead, your county was included in the Transition analysis that occurred in March. You should have previously received a memo with the results of that data analysis.
